



# KENTUCKY AUCTION NEWSLETTER

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## LICENSE RENEWAL

The renewal form is mailed to all licensees in late May. A principal auctioneer must complete 6 hours of continuing education (CE) by June 30th. An apprentice auctioneer or an auction house operator must report 3 hours of CE by June 30th. Mail or fax copies of CE completion documents to the Board. If you attend any of the Board sponsored seminars, your file will automatically be updated. Renewal will not be processed unless the continuing education is complete.

The renewal form and \$130 fee is due in the board office on or before Wednesday June 30, 2004.

This is not a postmark deadline!

If CE is complete, but the renewal is received from July 1 through December 31, 2004 an additional late fee will be required.

If continuing education is not completed by 6/30/04, renewal is not accepted, license is canceled and 1) examination is required for reinstatement or 2) an initial application with all attachments is submitted by those who were licensed by reciprocity.
