

KENTUCKY BOARD OF AUCTIONEERS Meeting Minutes February 9, 2020 Bowling Green, KY Motions denoted by *

Chairman Cliff-Ed Irvin called the meeting of the Kentucky Board of Auctioneers to order at 8:35 A.M. C.T. Immediately Danny Ray Ford was sworn in for a term expiring October 31, 2022.

PRESENT

Chairman Cliff-Ed Irvin, Vice Chairman Ron Kirby Jr, Board members Paul Playforth, Rodney Eldridge, Danny Ford and Administrative Coordinator Lavonne Bowling.

MINUTES

• *The minutes of November 13, 2019 were reviewed and unanimously approved on a motion from Ron Kirby Jr seconded by Rodney Eldridge, all in favor.

NEW BUSINESS/OLD BUSINESS/MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

- The Board discussed the current office situation. As of today's date, the Kentucky Real Estate Authority is without an Executive Director and legal team.
- *The board reviewed a letter from Kenneth Byrd sent on behalf of Jaden Gingerich. Mr Gingerich failed to renew his apprentice license by June 30th, 2019. The letter requested that Mr Gingrich be allowed to sit for the principal exam. On a motion from Ron Kirby Jr, seconded by Rodney Eldridge with a unanimous vote, Mr Gingerich must retake the apprentice exam to restart his auctioneer license, per KRS 330.060(5).
- The sweeping of funds was discussed.
- There were eight candidates who sat for the December examination, all attained a passing grade.
- A license statistic report for 2019 was presented to the board for review and discussion.
- The April board meeting is rescheduled for the 15th of April.

- The board answered questions from attendees regarding the sweeping of funds, facebook auctions, deregulation of licenses across the nation and universal auction licenses for mutual states.
